Disaster

 a calamitous event, especially one occurring suddenly and causing great loss of life, damage, or hardship, as a flood, airplane crash, or business failure.

Security

- freedom from danger, risk, etc.; safety.

How Disasters Threaten Security

- Loss of Shelter
- Loss of Mobility
- Loss of Food/Water
- Loss of Electricity
- Loss of Health/Life
- Loss of Economic Opportunity

Understanding Threats

- Direct
 - Floodwaters
 - Falling Debris
 - Flames
 - Resource Conflict
- Indirect
 - Hygiene/Medicine
 - Economic Impact

 - Civil Disorder
- 2010 House Flood (personal)
 - Financial Impact
- Japanese Earthquake 2011
 - Compound Disaster

Rule of 3's

- 3 Minutes without air
- 3 Hours without shelter
- 3 Days without water
- 3 Weeks without food

Plan to Survive

- Have a plan
 - Be aware of potential disasters
 - Contingency Plans for each
- Practice your plan
 - Every day disasters
- Not having a plan is planning to fail

Elements of a Plan

- Where to go?
 - Somewhere Safe
- What to do?
 - Do it quickly!
- What to bring?
 - Food/Water
 - Hygiene/First Aid
 - Shelter

Prepare!

- Mental
 - Role-playing
 - What ifs
- Physical
 - Emergency Kit
 - Place to go
 - Contact List

Mental

- Role Playing
 - Friends and family (children especially)
 - Discuss Plans [A-Z]
- What ifs
 - When to effect a plan

Physical

- Emergency Kit (more later)
- Place to go
 - Arrange a place to go with friends or family
- Contact list
 - List of names and phone numbers
